bravely (adv) – capable of dealing with danger or pain, without seeming to be frightened

costume (n) – clothes that performers wear in a play, movie, etc.

dorm (n) – a dormitory; a large room where a lot of people sleep, for example in a school or army camp

exchange (n) – an arrangement in which people or groups from different countries visit each other

or do each other's jobs, for example, to study another country's language or improve relationships

hastily (adv) – done in a hurry because you do not have much time

nearby (adj) – not far away

sleepyhead (n) – used for referring to someone, especially a child, when they have been sleeping and have started to wake up

strike a pose (phr) – to put your body into a particular position in order to create a particular effect

theatrically (adv) – expressing emotions in an excessive, silly or embarrassing way

workshop (n) – an occasion when a group of people meet to learn about a particular subject, especially by taking part in discussions or activities
