dough (n) – a mixture of flour, water, and shortening that is baked to make bread or pastry

expensive (adj) – something that costs a lot of money

flour (n) – a white or brown powder made by crushing grains

ham (n) – the meat from the top part of the back legs of a pig or turkey preserved using salt or smoke

on sale (phr) – available for people to buy at a price that is lower than the usual price

round up (v) – to increase a number to the nearest whole number, or the nearest number ending in zero

topping (n) – a layer of food put on top of other food
